

News from ASLA: Updates from our Trustee

Strategic Development

The ASLA Fund is launching a campaign to coincide with World Landscape Architecture Month to increase membership for **the Founders Club**. The ASLA Fund is continuing to raise funds to join the Discovery Education STEM Careers Coalition to advance our career discovery efforts. Also, funds are being donated to promote and take action on the Climate Action Plan.



Government Affairs

As of March 10, 46 states are now in legislative session for 2023. State Government Affairs is <u>tracking 117 occupational licensing bills</u>. Occupational licensure deregulation and/or reform continues to be a hot topic for legislatures and Governors to address. As licensure bills and legislation specific to the landscape architecture profession are introduced, <u>members and chapters can track them on the ALSA website</u>.

ASLA signed onto a letter with fellow **National Parks Second Century Action Coalition** members to express support and request additional funding regarding our nation's national parks in the upcoming congressional appropriations process for Fiscal Year 2024. Requests included increased investments to construct, restore, maintain, and improve park infrastructure and natural and cultural resources. Specifically, the letter called for federal funding to modernize national parks, enhance and expand visitor experiences, promote tourism and economic development by improving transportation and the National Scenic Byways Program, and more.
