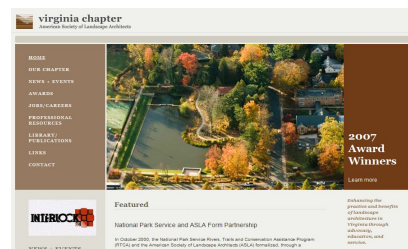
MORE EDUCATIONAL, SOCIAL AND NETWORKING EVENTS in 2010
