New and updated ASLA Public Policies have been released! The ASLA Board of Trustees, during their fall meeting, approved updates to multiple public policies. Updates were made to the policy on [Climate Change and Resilience](#) and to the suite of six policies related to licensure—[Professional Licensure](#); [Definition of Practice](#); [Qualifications for Licensure](#); [Reciprocity](#); [Enforcement](#); and [Post-Nominal Letters](#). Additionally, the Board approved a brand-new policy on [Biodiversity](#).

The deadline for receiving Letters of Interest/Resumes and Recommendation Letters/Resumes is December 10, 2023 at 12:00 pm.

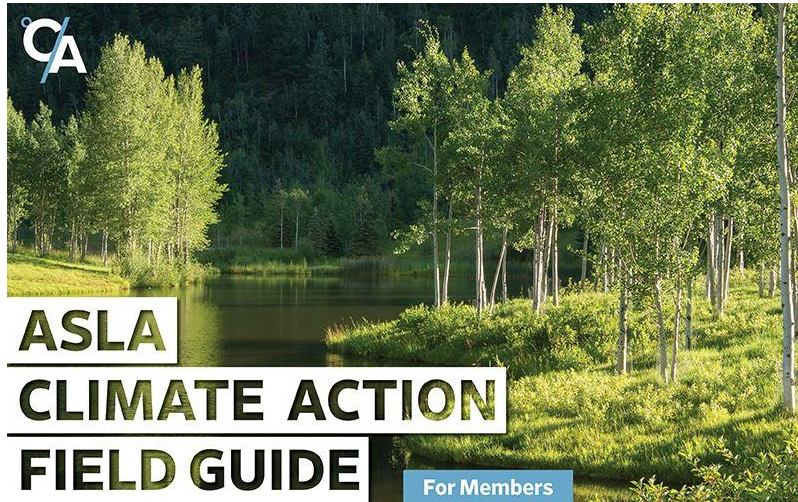
