

Senior Landscape Architect

The University of Virginia seeks to hire a Senior Landscape Architect to serve under the direction of the Architect for the University in the Office of the Architect. The Senior Landscape Architect serves as a planning and design representative on capital and non-capital projects including infrastructure, energy and utilities, athletics, intramural, stormwater management, parking facilities, residential, academic and research. The Senior Landscape Architect also serves as a representative on capital projects with significant site and civil scopes, and provides landscape architecture expertise to land use planning and real estate projects.

The ideal candidate must be service-oriented and have the ability to work successfully on a large variety of projects as a key team member, either independently or in a multi-disciplinary group, in a dynamic, fast-paced environment. They must possess demonstrated planning-related written and graphic work products. They must also have knowledge, abilities and strengths in landscape planning and design, horticulture, historic landscape preservation, storm water management, sustainability, and land use planning.
